Upstate History Alliance Awards

HEART'S DELIGHT FARM HERITAGE EXHIBIT RECEIVES HISTORY AWARD

The William H. Miner Agricultural Research Institute in Chazy, NY, was recently awarded a 2004 Certificate of Commendation from the Upstate History Alliance (UHA) for its new Heart's Delight Farm Heritage Exhibit. These certificates are awarded annually by the UHA as part of its Award of Merit program, which recognizes outstanding work in the regional history and museum community. The Heart's Delight Farm Heritage Exhibit is one of only six organizations to receive a Certificate in 2004.

The Upstate History Alliance, located in Oneonta, NY, is a non-profit organization that provides support, advice, and training to historical societies, museums, historians, and others interested in history in upstate New York. Each year its Award of Merit program recognizes outstanding and innovative projects in the history and museum community. Projects selected to receive a Certificate of Commendation represent excellence within the context of available means and regional standards.
